Regulatory Agency	Ministry of Health and Welfare (MoHW), Ministry of Food and Drug Safety (Korea MFDS)
Regulation Name or System Name	Korea Drug Serialization System, Korea Pharmaceutical Information Services (KPIS)
Compliance Dates	All drugs imported must be serialized by January 1, 2015, unless the importer submitted a plan prior to October 1, 2015 with a different date, prior to January 1, 2016.
	Government reporting started in 2016: Between January 1, 2016 and July 1, 2016, data may be reported, with no penalty for not reporting. Starting on July 1, 2016 reporting became mandatory.
Applies to	Prescription drug suppliers: manufacturers, importers and wholesalers

Barcode Data Encoding	GS1 standard	
Product Code notes	The KD Code is apparently a GTIN-13 assigned by GS1 South Korea specifically for drugs, or by the government, in cooperation with GS1 South Korea. The KD Code is converted to a GTIN-14 by prepending a zero.	
Free Samples must be marked?	Yes, unless the product is exempt	
Stickering after manufacturing allowed?	Not discussed
